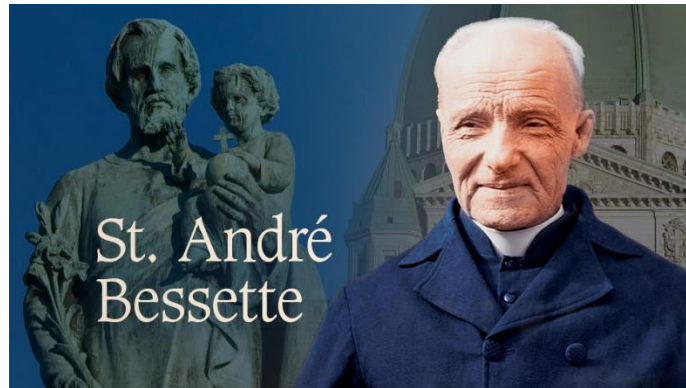


ST. ANDRE BESSETTE MINISTRY

Greeters



- Arrive to Mass a half hour early and stand by the welcome sign.
- Greet people with a smile and pray for the people coming through our doors, especially asking the intercession of St. Joseph and St. Andre Bessette.
- Hold the door if necessary.
- Do not get caught up in conversation to the neglect of others.
- Find out from Dave Roerick in the sacristy (i.e. where priests get ready for Mass) if there is coffee & doughnuts in the social hall after Mass. If so, you might let people know as they walk in.
- Do not pass out bulletins; bulletins are received after Mass at St Joes.
- If you recognize unfamiliar faces, make sure these people feel welcome - that they are always welcome. Point out the bathrooms to them and let them know to sit wherever in the main body of the church or the cry hall if they have young children.
- Conclude greeting when Mass begins.
- Check the schedule, posted on the bulletin board outside the sacristy, to sign up for other greeting opportunities.
