



A MESSAGE FROM DEACON STEVE SCHULER

May the peace of the Lord be with you always



To begin with, on behalf of Fr. Blake, myself, and really all members of St. Joseph & St. Augustine Catholic Community, we welcome your interest with enthusiasm and encourage you to explore joining the Catholic Church. There are approximately 1.4 billion Catholics worldwide, filling more than 221,700 parishes. Each year, thousands of adults like yourself might be feeling a spiritual pull, or might be drawn by the teachings of Jesus Christ and His Church, or the richness of the sacraments, or the beauty of the Mass, or who are simply interested in the Catholic faith.

The process of seeking baptism or to become full members of the Catholic Church is called, the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA). It's a formation process in which you have the opportunity to: (1) Grow and develop your relationship with God; (2) study the Gospel - the Word of God - the Bible; (3) become familiar with the Catholic teachings, beliefs, and practices; (4) Profess our faith in Jesus Christ (and the Blessed Trinity); and (5) Grow in fellowship with one another.

I know this sounds like a lot, but don't worry, it's a journey over a lifetime. Someone once told me, learning to be a follower of Christ is not a sprint but a marathon. That's true. There are no tests or grades. No pressure or worries. We only ask for your participation in an ancient journey that is taken one step at a time.

OCIA is for individuals who have never been baptized, or come from another faith tradition, or were baptized Catholic but did not complete the Sacrament of Confirmation.

For those seeking baptism, OCIA leads toward becoming members of the body of Christ - adoption into the family of God - cleansing from original sin. infilling with the Holy Spirit, and reception of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. For those already baptized in a different Christian tradition, OCIA leads toward full Communion with the Catholic Church, reception of the Holy Eucharist and strengthening in living a full Christian life with the power of the Holy Spirit through Confirmation.

The kickoff for OCIA will start:

Tuesday, September 23, 2025 6:30PM | Social Hall | St. Joseph

Thank you for your interest in taking the first step in your journey to greater understanding of the Catholic faith. We trust that the Holy Spirit will guide your journey toward an ever-growing relationship with Our Lord, Jesus Christ. Fr. Blake, myself, and other volunteers would love to walk with you every step of the way in the OCIA process.






